#### **KO-BUDO LEVEL 1** (Chief Instructors Recommendation)

Level 1 applicants to have demonstrated regular attendance and input at the majority of Ko-Budo Courses and to have reached a very high standard of both working and teaching, absorbing all new work as well as <u>all</u> the previous.

ALL DAN GRADE STUDENTS WILL BE EXPECTED TO ATTEND A MINIMUM OF 2 KOBUDO COURSES PER YEAR. REGULAR PRACTISE DURING CLASS TIME IS ALSO REQUIRED TO MAINTAIN A GOOD STANDARD FOR DAN GRADINGS.ALL KO-BUDO INSTRUCTORS WILL BE REGULARLY ASSESSED.
